

CBS were asked to provide feasibility advice for a client adapting her home for her son who is significantly disabled by a brain injury. His care needs were significant and adaptations were proposed to improve his independence and quality of life. CBS advised on the adaptations necessary in order to improve the facilities both for the young man's care and the rest of the family.
